Dress Code

All employees must conform to the uniform dress code as follows:

- All employees must be clean and neatly attired.
- All employees are required to wear their Name Badges.
- Shoes must be polished at all times.
- While in the Preparation Room and/or the Dressing/Casketing Room Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and Clothing are to be used following Universal Precautions.

For Women: Black Suits, white blouse, or black dresses with or without white accents and black shoes are required on all Church Services. Black or Dark Blue Suits, white blouse, or black dresses with or without white accents and black shoes may be worn on Chapel Services. A skirt and blazer, or a dress or a business suit of the appropriate length and color may be worn. Blazers must be of a moderate length (no less than four inches below the waistline). Blouses and dresses should be moderate without the display of cleavage. Skirts or dresses should be of moderate length (no less than one inch below the knee and no more than angle length). Shoes must be shined at all times and of moderate heel height. Stockings must be of a muted color. Fishnets and patterned stockings are not allowed. Moderate Make-up may be worn. Moderate earrings may be worn. During inclement weather, slacks may be worn to the cemetery or to make a transfer of remains to the funeral home. Slacks are not to be worn on the funeral service. Boots may be worn during inclement weather. Dark overcoats must be worn on Services. All clothing must be appropriately tailored.

For Men: Black suits, white shirts, uniform ties and black shoes are required for all Church Services. Black or Dark Blue Suits, white shirts, uniform ties and black shoes may be worn on Chapel Services. On days when there are no services, slacks and blazers may be worn. No earrings are to be worn. Boots may be worn during inclement weather. Dark overcoats must be worn on Services. All clothing must be appropriately tailored.

Hair: Hairstyles should be moderate. Men's hair should not reach below the collar level. Tinted or bleached hair must be moderate.

Body Piercing: Visible piercing is not allowed in the work place.

Jewelry: A moderate amount of jewelry may be worn.

Nails: Men and women's nails must be of moderate length and kept neat and clean. Nail Polish must be moderate.

Tattoos: Tattoos cannot be visible in the workplace.
